	Macabeo Sauvignon Blanc Nucli, Neleman, 2023 VALENCIA, SPAIN – ORGANIC Fresh, aromatic but really ripe Sauvignon Blanc from Southern Spain, ripe lemon and peach characters balanced by fresh acidity, ideal with seafood.	35.00
	Chardonnay Muscat Signature, Neleman, 2023 VALENCIA, SPAIN – ORGANIC Well balanced wine with fresh and ripe fruit flavours with a little bit of richness and aromatic dimension from the Muscat, a perfect match to seasonal asparagus and slightly spicy dishes.	35.00
	Pinot Noir Gamay, Domaine de la Rochette, 2024 LOIRE, FRANCE A light and juicy red from the Loire displaying red fruit characters and light tannins, served lightly chilled it will be a delicious alternative to white wines for seafood dishes and light red meat dishes.	39.00
	Bordeaux Blend, Soli Rouge, Miroglio, 2021 THRACE, BULGARIA Using varieties that you normally find in Bordeaux, Miroglio produces this stunning wine that displays jammy and spicy notes, light tannins, and an herbal finish, perfect with spring lamb.	45.00

Its complexity and its minerality is very much reminiscent of a top quality dry Riesling.	64.95
RED	55	Mencia, Petit Pittacum, 2022 BIERZO – VEGAN The region of Bierzo, inland of Galicia in the northwest of Spain, benefits from a unique microclimate which aids the winemaking process. Made with the local Mencia variety, Medium bodied, really juicy red fruit and cranberry characters with hints of herbs and spice.	44.95
	57	Garnacha “La Bruja de la Rozas”, Comando G, 2022 SIERRA DE GREDOS, MADRID – VEGAN “La Bruja” consists of grapes from 50-80 year old vines based on granite soils, which are then fermented using wild yeasts before spending around 5 months in French oak. The resultant wine is young, fresh and playful, acting as a fantastic introduction to the potential of Garnacha from this intriguing, up-and-coming sub-region.	82.95
